

ITALIAN VIRTUAL RALLY CHAMPIONSHIP 2026 © SEVENSIMWORLD – REGULATIONS

1- For the 2026 season, Seven SIMWORLD is pleased to continue the collaboration with RallySimFans.hu for the management of the Italian Virtual Rally Championship '26; in updates and highlights the acronym CIRV will be used. The championship will once again take place on the RSF platform, using the latest update of the NGP7 physics. Anyone with an account may participate; all information, communications, news and updates will be published on our Discord channel (<https://discord.gg/bKemeY5eSh>) and on our social profiles Facebook and Instagram (@SevenSIMWORLD).

2- To request technical support and information, each user may contact us on the Discord channel in the appropriate section (technical support); to ensure more effective handling it is recommended to tag @admin under your request. It will be necessary to specify your first and last name and your RSF nickname; any request lacking these requirements will be ignored.

3- Championship registrations will always remain open but will be temporarily closed during the running of each rally on the calendar; it is strictly forbidden to have a double account. Anyone found ignoring this rule will be immediately excluded and disqualified from the competition.

4- Each user is required to keep a copy of the replays of each race for at least 48 hours after the end of the event, in case the organization or other users request post-race checks and verifications.

THE CHAMPIONSHIP

5- The championship will consist of 7 events, all on asphalt surface. The duration of each single rally will be 7 days, from Monday to Sunday.

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- 1- Rally del Ciocco 30-03 / 6-04 2026
- 2- Rally Targa Florio 18-05 / 24-05 2026
- 3- Rally Due Valli 8-06 / 14-06 2026
- 4- Rally Roma Capitale 6-07 / 12-07 2026
- 5- Rally Regione Piemonte 3-08 / 9-08 2026
- 6- Rally del Lazio 14-09 / 20-09 2026
- 7- Rally di Sanremo 19-10 / 25-10 2026

7- Plugin Setup:

* SUPERALLY: Super Rally will be available only for users who do not finish the first leg; all those who have problems in the final leg will not be able to use Super Rally and will be automatically excluded from the final classification at the time of points calculation.

8- Before each event, the Rally Roadbook will be published on our social channels with:

- rally name
- name and length of the special stages
- service park
- special stage conditions

9- JUNIOR TROPHY: in parallel with the overall virtual championship, the Junior Trophy reserved for RALLY 4 class cars will be contested and will have its own classification; for the calculation of points the same methodology as the CIRV class points will be adopted.

10- Race numbers: each user will have their own race number to be applied to the official championship plates; the starting number will be the user's RSF User ID, visible on their profile on the rallysimfans.hu website. This except for priority drivers, namely all those who in the previous season achieved a placement in the various classes. The "low" starting numbers will be assigned to a list of priority drivers which will be viewable in the next paragraph of these regulations; each priority driver may choose whether to use the number corresponding to their User ID or the priority number. In the event that a driver chooses not to use their priority number, it will not be transferable to any other user and will remain unused until the end of the season. For the following season, numbers will be assigned again following a priority list based on the classifications of the 2026 season.

11- Priority drivers:

1- Luca Raia – OVERALL WINNER

2- Marco Cassano – JUNIOR TROPHY WINNER

Plate/Graphics: within this section on the Discord server there is a ZIP file with the official plates for the 2026 season and the related instructions on how to apply them. Inside the file there are also some logos of companies that have decided to support us this season; these logos must be applied on the liveries of each team (this also applies to private drivers who intend to publish photos, images and videos) in positions and sizes deemed appropriate by each skinner, as mandatory advertising, but they must in any case be visible and recognizable. We will not ask for any contribution from users, therefore we rely on the good faith of everyone in virtually promoting companies and brands that contribute to the creation of the Championship.

12- Photo/Video: within this section of the Discord server, users may post images and clips of their races, with comments and considerations on their performance and results. As usual, we ask for maximum sharing and participation since we carry out daily updates and posts; for the 2026 season live broadcasts will also be organized with protagonists and participants of the championship, with interviews, analysis and insights.

13- Car classes: competitors may obtain placements for the overall classification and for that of their own class and GROUP among the following:

- MODERN

Rally 2/R5 – RALLY4/R2 (JUNIOR) – RALLY3 – RALLY5 – RGT – R1 (Rally6)

- CLASSIC

S.2000/R4 – N4 – A7 (NO KIT)/R3 – A6 – S1600

- HISTORIC

GRA8/GR4

14- Points:

15- Each user may select two car classes with which to register and may regularly start with one or the other throughout the season, scoring points in both classes; in the event that a driver is the winner of two different classes, the class in which they made the most starts will be taken into account. In the event of a tie on points between two or more drivers, the driver who achieved the better placements will be considered.

16- Power Stage: NO.

17- Team Registration: each team manager has the duty to "register" their team within the appropriate section of the Discord server (Team registration), indicating the team name and the link to the RSF website.

18- Penalties and communications: penalties automatically detected by the system for track cutting will be applied; furthermore, at the end of each event, the Race Direction may reserve the right to randomly draw or, in relation to possible time anomalies in certain special stages, select some

drivers, asking them to send the replay of a specific SS. A team of observers will review the replays to verify any irregularities; cases of track cutting (4 wheels outside the roadway) will be considered a violation and an extra time penalty will be added based on the severity of the cut, except in cases of cuts due to errors or accidents.

Drivers selected for verification will be notified in the appropriate section of the Discord server (race direction and communications) and it is the duty of team managers, or their representatives, to inform the drivers of their team. It is also a duty to carry out this check by private drivers (who are not excluded from possible checks).

Each driver will have 48 hours to send their replay to the following email: sevensimworld02@gmail.com, specifying first name, last name and RSF nickname, car, team of belonging and special stage of the replay.

In the event that a driver does not provide the replay within the time limit, they will be automatically disqualified from the race; if the replay does not present irregularities, no communication will follow, otherwise any penalty will be notified in the appropriate Discord server room.

Liveries and replays: at the end of the race, the first three classified drivers of each class will be notified of a SS for which to send the replay. It is MANDATORY to send the replay file and the LIVERY file within 48 hours from the request of the Race Direction. Upon the second failure to send, disqualification from the championship will occur without appeal.

No request for restart will be taken into consideration by the organization in the event of a game crash and it is to be considered a technical problem during the race.

19- Team Classification: also for the 2026 season Seven Sim World is pleased to confirm the special classification reserved for teams, with the same method used in the past season. Each team manager will have the duty to present their list of drivers belonging to the team, by means of a list or simply with a screenshot directly from the rallysimfans.hu website. This list must be communicated in the appropriate section of the Discord server (team registration) by 29/03/2026.

Any communications received after this date will be taken into consideration starting from the following championship round (obviously the sum of points will not take into account previous rounds; the sum of points is not retroactive).

The same rule applies to any "hiring" of new drivers into the team.

At the time of exporting the classifications of each event, it will be up to the organization to associate the drivers in the classification to the respective team and proceed with the calculation as follows: the best 5 results will be counted for the team classification; this means that the 5 drivers who obtain the best placements in the various classes will contribute to forming the team classification. No class will have precedence over another; the 5 best results of each team will be identified in an ordinary manner.

Only teams that have completed their registration in the appropriate section of the Discord server and have communicated their list of drivers will compete in the team classification; all those who have not done so will not take part in the classification, but will not be "transparent", meaning they may still take points away from registered teams.

20- In this new season the LADY'S TROPHY dedicated to female crews will be established. To register it will be sufficient to provide name and number and a document (copy) to be sent to our DISCORD in the section dedicated to the LADY'S TROPHY.

The organization reserves the right to modify or extend these regulations, even during the season, in order to ensure a correct and regular running of the championship. Seven Sim World wishes to thank you for your collaboration and support, wishing everyone a season full of fun, passion and

respect.
